BE IT ENACTED by the Queen's Most Excellent Majesty, by and with the advice and consent of the Senate and the House of Representatives and by the authority of the same as follows—

1. This Act may be cited as the—

3. Sub-section (2) of the principal Act is hereby repealed and the following substituted therefor;

“(2) (a) The staff of the Commission shall consist of an Executive Director and such other staff as shall be necessary for the efficient operation of the Commission.

(b) The functions of the office of the Executive Director and other staff shall be exercised by persons with the requisite qualifications who hold or act in such public offices designated in that behalf by the public Service Commission acting on the recommendation of the Anti Money Laundering and Combating Terrorism Financing Commission”.
